





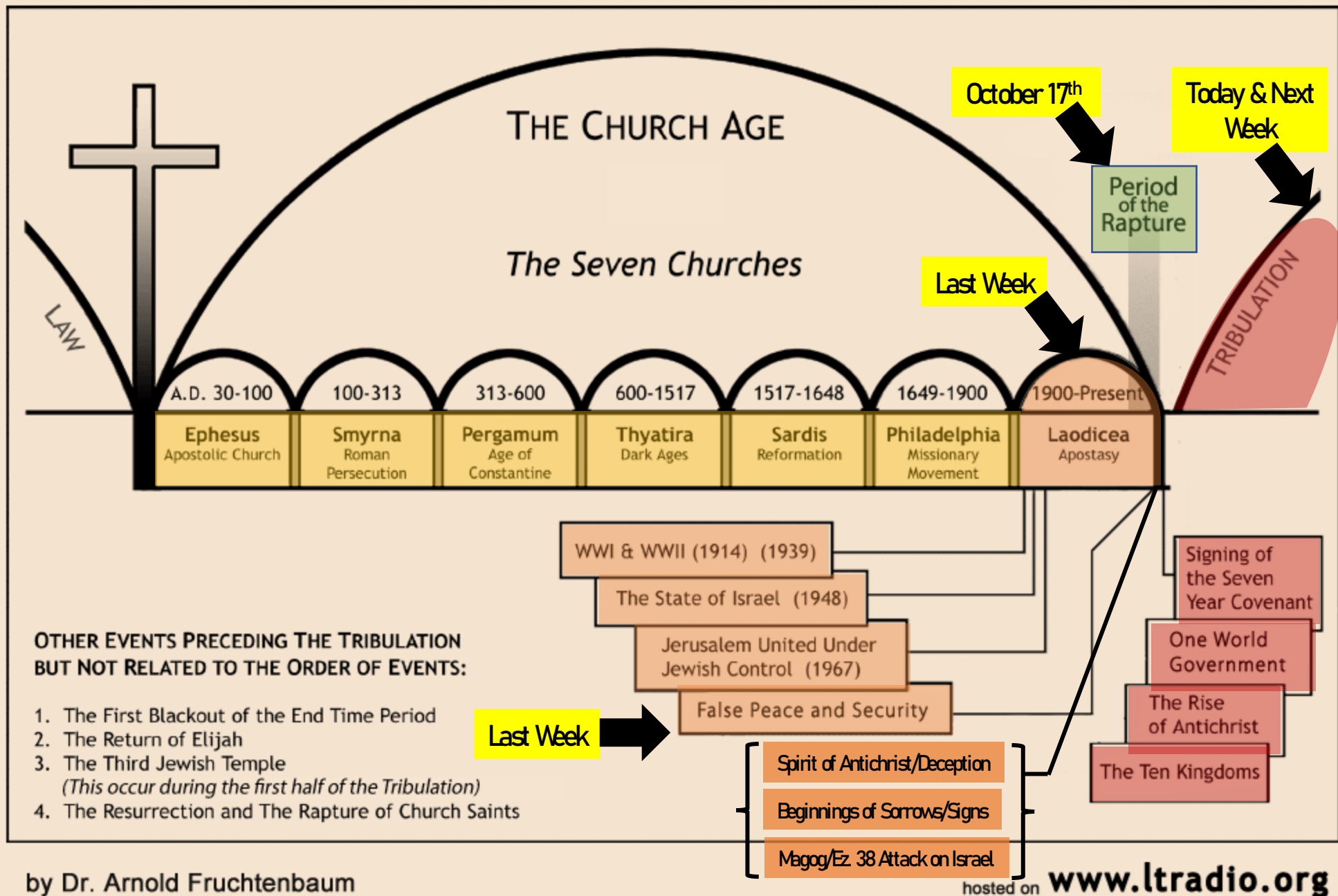

Olivet Discourse — The Tribulation

Matthew 24 | Mark 13 | Luke 21



Jesus' Tribulation Outline:

Matthew 24, Mark 13, Luke 21 | Matthew 24:15 ...Whoever reads, let him understand.

1. The coming of the prophesied Abomination of Desolation (The Antichrist)
2. The Antichrist standing in the holy place (The Temple rebuilt)
3. Those in Judea should flee to the mountains/wilderness
4. The time of tribulation will be unlike anything in the history of the world
5. Unless the days were shortened – not a single person would survive
6. The days are shortened only for sake of the elect (those that believe on Jesus)
7. False christs, false prophets, and deceptive supernatural signs will deceive many
8. Even the elect will be deceived if it were possible
9. These signs will indicate the 2nd coming of Jesus is rapidly approaching
10. There's a place where both carcass and feeding birds will gather
11. The distress of nations, with perplexity, the sea & waves roaring (Luke 21)
12. Men's hearts failing them for fear of those things coming upon the earth (Luke 21)
13. The heavens will be shaken, the skies darkened, and objects from space will fall
14. **The Son of Man will come in the clouds and gather ALL HIS ELECT together!!!**

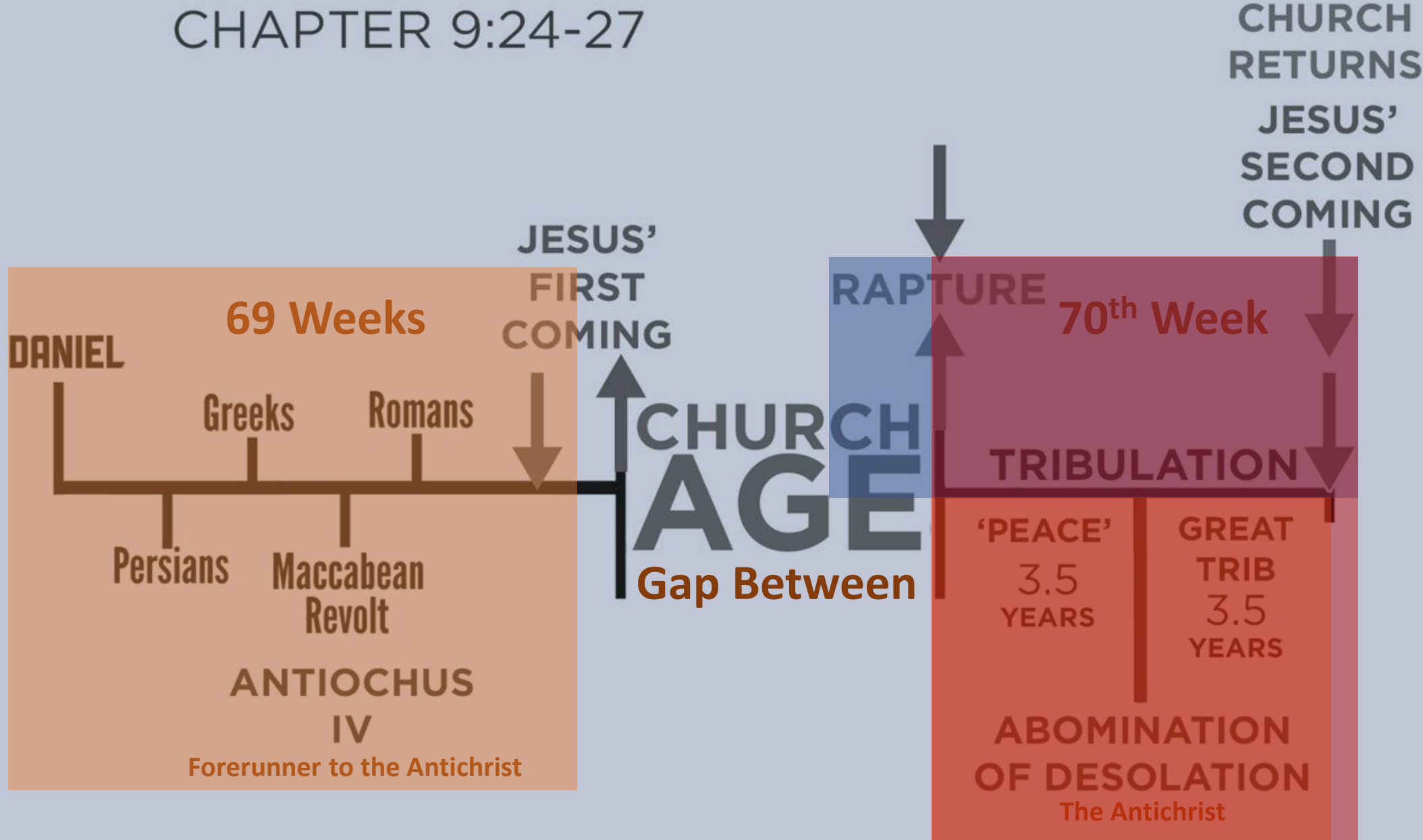
Elsewhere in the Tanakh (OT) — The Tribulation

The Torah teaches that the positive commandment to build the Temple was given by G-d to the Jewish people at Mount Sinai, the day following Yom Kippur. It is counted as one of the 613 mitzvot, the commandments that Israel is perpetually obligated to fulfill.

In his classic work The Book of the Commandments, the great authority Maimonides explains the details of each one of the Torah's commandments. Here, he explains G-d's instructions to build the Temple as follows:

"The Creator commanded us to erect a chosen House for His service, where the sacrificial offerings will be brought for all time. And the processions and festive pilgrimages will be conducted there three times a year."

The verse states: "And they shall make for Me a sanctuary, and I will dwell amongst them" (Exodus 25:8). We have explained that this commandment is general and includes many details: the menorah, the table, the altar, etc. These are all intrinsic parts of the Temple and all of the detailed ordinances of this commandment including the construction and its design are all explained in the tractate that was compiled for this purpose, Tractate Middot.

There are three major points that Maimonides teaches us here:

1. The purpose of the commandment of building the Temple is in order to offer the sacrifices, and it is a perpetual commandment that is binding upon every successive generation.
2. The vessels of the Temple are an intrinsic part of the commandment and constitute a portion of the Temple structure, and all the units, separately and together, are considered as one precept.
3. The accepted design of the Holy Temple is that which is described in Tractate Middot of the Babylonian Talmud. These principals are universally accepted as legally binding by the great Torah scholars throughout the generations

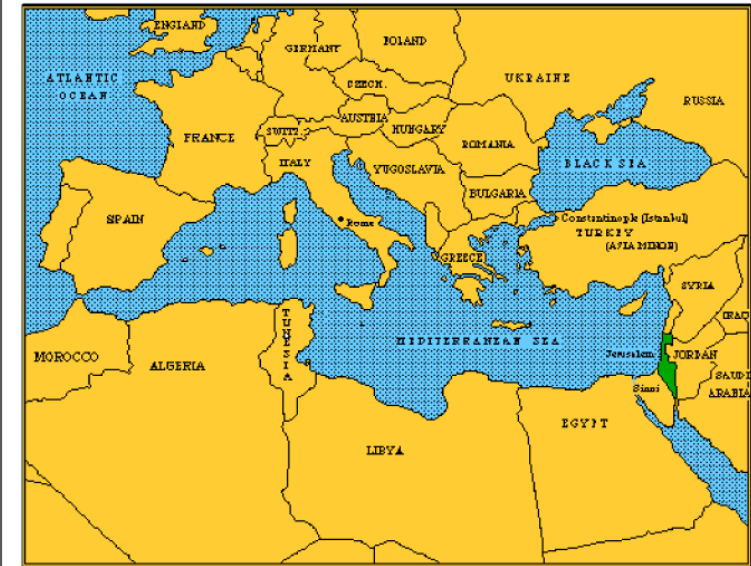

EUROPE AND THE MEDITERRANEAN

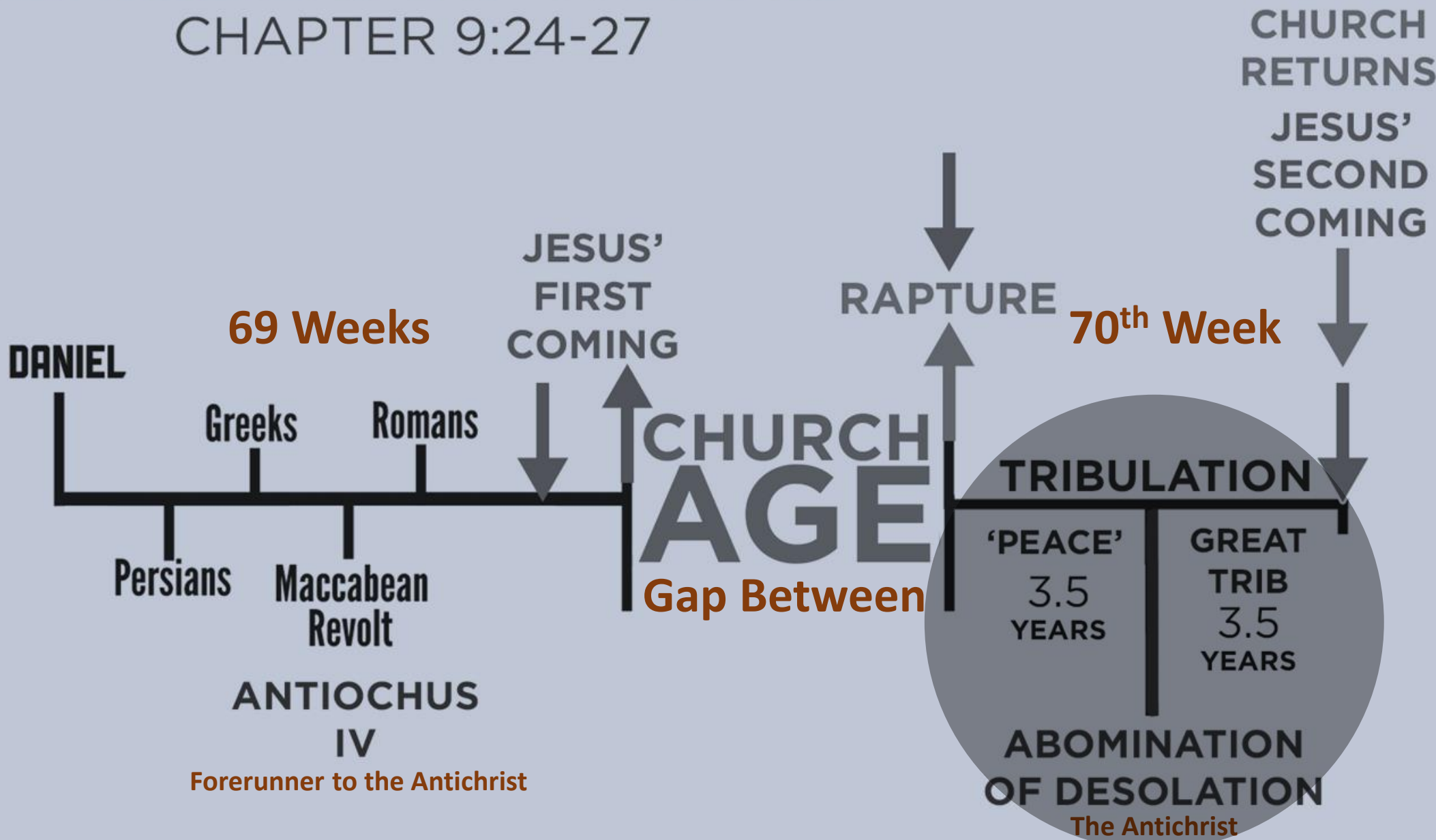

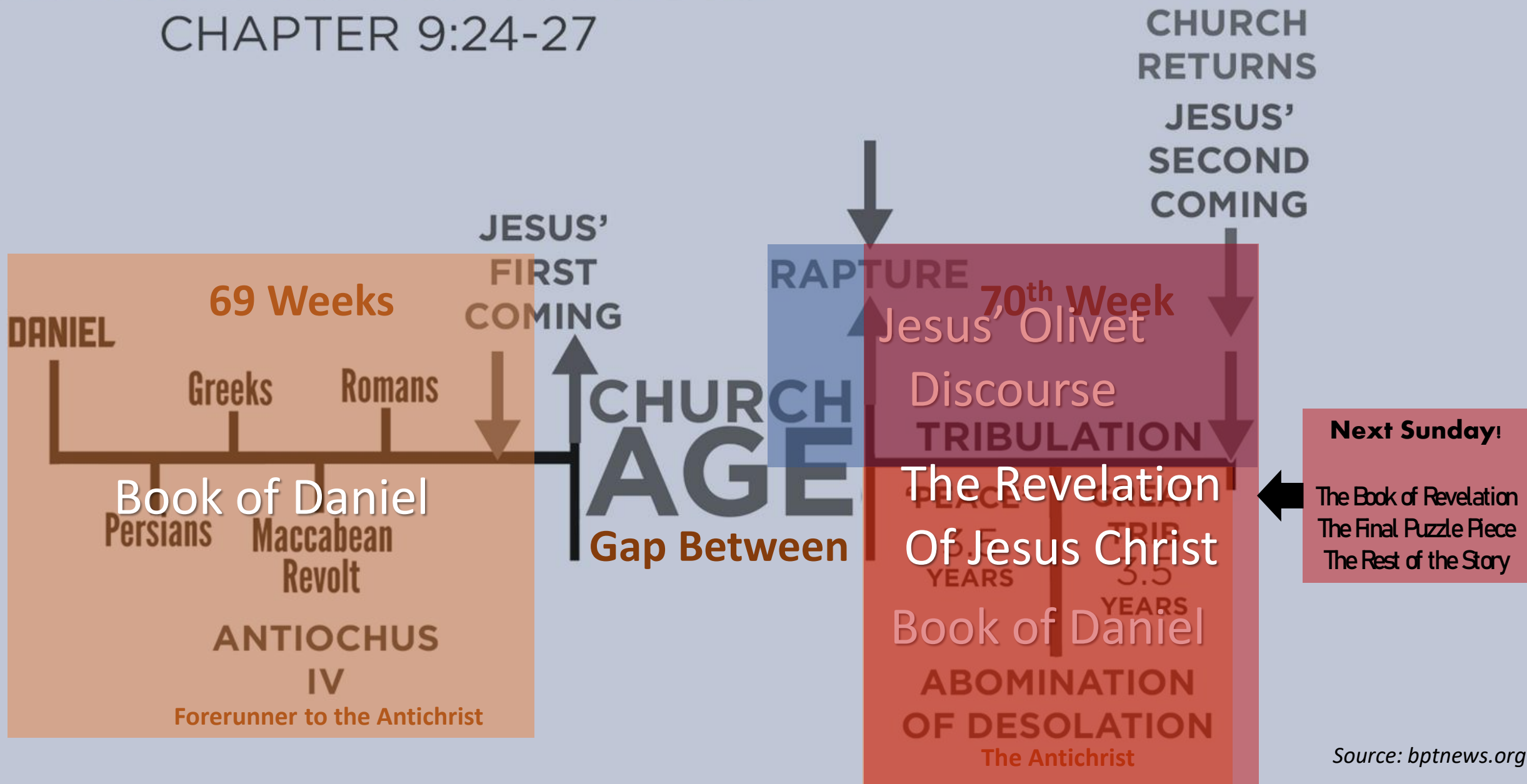



Daniel 11:37 He shall regard neither the God of his fathers nor the desire of women, nor regard any god; for he shall exalt himself above them all.


